When is the payment due?

The payment must be made on or before the 15th day of the 4th month following the end of the tax year to avoid any late payment penalty or interest.

How to make payment

Make check or money order payable to "ND State Tax Commissioner" and write last four digits of federal employer identification number (FEIN) and "2022 Form 60-PV" on it. Complete the payment voucher, detach it from this page, and enclose it with payment and return. If Form 60 has already been filed, mail payment and voucher to:

Only a check drawn on a U.S. or Canadian bank in U.S. dollars and using a standard 9-digit routing number is accepted.
