Sale of tangible personal property to a person from Montana is exempt *provided* (1) the **Montana customer is in the state of North Dakota to make a specific purchase**, (2) the sale of goods is fifty dollars or more and (3) the goods are removed from the state of North Dakota for use exclusively outside this state. *Person from Montana* means a natural person, corporation and other business entity when the owners, partners, or members are individual residents or domestic business entities from Montana.

I Hereby Certify that I am a resident of Montana in the state of North Dakota for the express purpose of making a purchase, as defined above. I understand that falsification of this form to evade payment of tax is a class A misdemeanor and may be punishable by a fine up to \$15,000, or imprisonment up to one year or both.

Note To Retailer: Request a form of identification, such as a Montana's driver's license, and insure the Certificate of Purchase is completed legibly.
