### **Appeal Process:**

- 1.) Appellant notifies the Property Tax Division of intent to appeal.
- 2.) Submit this form and all applicable documentation to propertytax@nd.gov by the date specified above.
- 3.) The State Board of Equalization meets on the second Tuesday in August to examine and compare the returns of the assessment of taxable property as submitted by North Dakota counties. This is locally assessed property. The board equalizes the property so that all assessments of similar taxable property are uniform and equal throughout the state. During this meeting, tax directors or other representatives from a county will speak, along with city representatives, and individual taxpayers.
- 4.) After the State Board meeting, your case will be assigned, and staff will reach out to schedule an onsite review of the property (when deemed applicable). While an interior inspection of the property is not required, interior reviews may affect the consideration of value. If denied an interior review, we will assess from the exterior only. Staff will not be allowed to enter the property without the owner or a representative present.
- 5.) Generally, by the first Thursday of October, the property tax division staff will present their findings to the State Board of Equalization with a recommendation. The board deliberates and votes. You can attend this meeting however; public comments are not accepted.
