File No.: 2023-WILLIAMS-COMMERCIAL TOLERANCE County or City: Williams County Appellant: Issue: Commercial Sales Ratio is not within tolerance.

Summary: The sales ratio study indicates a commercial sales ratio of 101%.

Analysis: Williams County's commercial property indicates a sales ratio of 101%. The Williams County Tax Director reports that commercial property is over-assessed countywide, not in specific cities or locations within the county.

State law prohibits the State Board of Equalization from approving valuations and assessments exceeding 100% of true and full value. Commercial property in Williams County exceeds 100% of true and full value and is not within tolerance. Commercial assessments must be reduced to bring the commercial sales ratio within tolerance.

Proposal for Review: Direct Williams County to decrease commercial assessments by 2% to an approximate value of \$3,249,977,081.
