Scott Tranby, Griggs County Commissioner, stated that the county had officially contracted Linda Morris in October 2024. Linda was contracted by Griggs County to complete the required reports and perform the re-assessment of the county. She gave a brief update of the work she had completed so far and the work yet to be done. She plans to give a quarterly update.

Commissioner Goehring moved and Treasurer Beadle seconded to approve to general range of 90% to 100% and if the tolerance was outside that range, it would be moved to 93% unless the historical average led the board to decide on a different percentage.
